For a traveling seminar:

- 1. \$250.00 per day.*
- 2. \$.45 per mile round trip for mileage by car or air fare equivalent to or less than the driving expense.*
- 3. Lodging in the hostess home or hotel or motel with meals provided.*
- 4. Portrait seminars are usually 4 or 5 days in length depending on the complexity of the project. It will be my decision as to the length of the class. Most subjects other than portraits can be accomplished in 4 days.*
- 5. Class size is usually 7 students, however for some less complex pieces, up to 10 students will be allowed. This will be at my discretion. For more than 8 students, there will be an additional \$50 per day per student added to the seminar fee.*
- 6. The new graphito technique can be taught in 2 days. The tile is prepared in the morning, fired to 450 degrees and cooled. The remainder of the first day will be exercises in practicing the scratching and shading with a mechanical pencil. The second day will be the execution of the graphito on the prepared tile.*

For a seminar in my home:

- 1. The seminar fee is the same. There will be a maximum of 5 students.*
- 2. Each student brings his/her lunch. I provide the beverage.*
- 3. I will do the firing each night.*

For each class, I will furnish the paint, painting medium, brush cleaner, the study and worksheets. There will be a charge for the materials of no more than \$15.00. Sometimes it is less – for instance painting in monochrome. This covers my printing and supply cost. The porcelain expense is extra also. The students may furnish their own porcelain or I can order it and be reimbursed by the students.

A \$250.00 deposit is required 60 days prior to the seminar. This deposit will be applied to the balance of the seminar fee. If I have to cancel for any reason, the deposit will be refunded. If you cancel before the 60 days, the deposit will be refunded. If you cancel within the 60 day period and reschedule, the deposit will be held until the next available date. If you cancel within the 60 day period and do not reschedule, the deposit is forfeited.
